



"Dizzy's on the money"

Terms and Conditions of Entry

- 1) The promotion is called "**Dizzy's on the money**" (**Promotion**).
- 2) By entering this Promotion, Participants accept and agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions of entry (**Terms and Conditions**). Information on how to enter and prize details form part of these Terms and Conditions.
- 3) The Promoter is Australian Central Credit Union Ltd trading as People's Choice Credit Union (**People's Choice**), ABN 11 087 651 125, Australian Financial Services Licence 244310 and Australian Credit Licence 244310 of 50 Flinders Street, Adelaide SA 5000. Ph: 13 11 82 (**Promoter**). The Promotion is conducted in South Australia.
- 4) The Promotion commences at each of the eight Adelaide Strikers' games played at Adelaide Oval during the BBL10 season commencing on Monday 28 December 2020 and closing on Monday 25th January 2021.
- 5) Prizes consist of:
 - (A) one (1) \$250 payment from People's Choice (**Prize**) following each of the eight Strikers games played at Adelaide Oval in BBL10. Eight (8) payments in total across eight Adelaide Strikers BBL10 season games, valued at \$2,000 total. Each winner then has the opportunity to double their winnings to \$500 by holding an active People's Choice Transaction Account (subject to eligibility) within four (4) weeks of winning, valued at a further \$2,000. Total Prize pool valued at up to \$4,000,.(each a **Prize** and, together, the **Prizes**).
- 6) To participate in the Promotion you must:
 - (A) be a resident in Australia;
 - (B) be aged 13 years or over
 - (C) be in attendance during the innings break at an Adelaide Strikers' game played at Adelaide Oval between 28 December 2020 and 25th January 2021
 - (D) raise a hand to indicate consent to participate in the Promotion when prompted by the MC
- 7) A prize winner will be selected from the participating audience in attendance during the innings break at each of the eight Adelaide Strikers' games played at Adelaide Oval during the BBL10 season.
- 8) The Prize winners will receive instructions (Instructions Letter), on the Terms as set out at 8(A) to 8(E) below, on how to claim the Prize amount at the time of being declared a Prize winner.
 - (A) To redeem the \$250 payment, the Prize winner must contact People's Choice by following the details set out in the Instructions Letter provided to them at the time of being declared a Prize winner. The \$250 payment can be deposited into any account of the Prize winner's choice. The \$250 payment must be claimed by the date listed in the Instruction Letter (see table below). The payment may be in the form of a cheque or electronic funds transfer as selected by People's Choice.

- (B) For the opportunity to double their winnings to \$500, the Prize winner is required to open, or already have, a transaction account with People’s Choice— such as an Activate, Zip or Everyday*^ (subject to eligibility criteria). The Prize winner can open an account by visiting a People’s Choice branch or via www.peopleschoicecu.com.au and follow the instructions to apply online. The ‘double your winnings’ offer must be claimed by the date listed in the Instruction Letter (see table below).
- (C) Once the new transaction account has been opened, or if the Prize winner already has an eligible transaction account with People’s Choice, the Prize winner needs to contact the People’s Choice person listed in the Instructions Letter provided and reference their:
- People’s Choice Credit Union member number
 - Transaction account number
 - Name and Surname
 - Reference number provided in the Instructions Letter.
- (D) Eligible Prize winners with an existing People’s Choice transaction account will receive the \$250 ‘double your winnings’ payment directly into their People’s Choice transaction account.
- (E) The opportunity for Prize winners to double their winnings expires on the date listed in the Instruction Letter, approximately 4 weeks from winning. Winners deemed ineligible to open a People’s Choice transaction account will receive the \$250 Prize only and will not be eligible for the opportunity to double their winnings.

- 9) The names of each Prize winner will be published on the Promoter’s Website two business days after each Strikers game

- 10) The Promoter reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and Participants and to disqualify any Participant who enters the Promotion that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
- 11) If there is a dispute as to the identity of a Participant, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the Participant.
- 12) The Promoter's decision is final in relation to all matters in this Promotion and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 13) If the Promoter determines that a winning entry does not comply with these Terms and Conditions, and therefore the Participant is ineligible to win the relevant prize, an immediate redraw for the prize will take place at the same location.
- 14) The collection and disclosure of personal information provided in connection with this Promotion will be handled in accordance with the Promoter's Privacy Policy, which adheres to the *Privacy Act 1988* (Cth) and the Australian Privacy Principles. - 19) If for any reason this Promotion is not capable of being run in the manner described in these Terms and Conditions, including but not limited to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupts or affect the administration security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Promotion, the Promoter reserves the right in its absolute discretion cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this Promotion at any time, subject to any directions from a regulatory authority.
